 - Hold a current enhanced DBS (Disclosures & Barring Service) check and ensure it is valid for NORJAM 2018.
 - Have an understanding of internet websites and what is suitable and safe and what is not.
 - Have confidence to ask a participant / staff member to leave the Internet Café if you feel their conduct / websites are not relevant and report the individual(s) to the Jamboree Director(s)
 - Have knowledge and understanding of the guidelines set out by www.thinkyouknow.co.uk
 - Be friendly, welcoming and have a personable approach.
 - Have experience of handling cash.
 - Be willing to work at obscure times and unsociable hours!
 - Be very organised and the ability to keep extremely accurate records.
 - Ensure the internet café is built, tested and operational by Friday evening, prior to the Jamboree.
