

Caravans and Motorhomes

As a Jamboree, we wish to ensure that all of our volunteers are accommodated on-site. Whilst many enjoy a "back to basics" approach, a few need alternative accommodation.

Alternative accommodation options are by the express permission of the Director of Site Services and are as follows:

- Caravan
- Motorhome (any motor vehicle equipped like a caravan for living in, be it purpose built or adapted to include living accommodation)

Whilst we will endeavour to accommodate all preferred choices, due to space limitations, we may need to restrict the number of caravans and motorhomes. As part of the Phase 2 booking process, you will be required to provide the reason(s) you require an alternative to camping in a tent. All caravans and motorhomes will be allocated pitches in a dedicated area, and it will not be possible for you to camp with friends camping in tents.

Safety is paramount; therefore, users of caravans and motorhomes have a responsibility to minimise potential dangers by adhering to the following rules:

- Use only the allocated pitch space (which includes the use of awnings).
- Correctly secure your caravan or motorhome; adding chocks to caravan and motorhome wheels to prevent movement and leave motorhomes in gear, or in park if auto, with the handbrake applied.
- Position gas cylinders in a safe and secure manner; if unsure, seek advice.
- Keep external cables and pipes neat and out of the way, and mark potential trip hazards

Caravan and motorhome users are expected to abide by guidelines in the Staff Handbook. In addition, they are required to adhere to the following:

- 1. Report to your pre-arranged meeting point on arrival.
- 2. Park towing vehicles only in the Staff Car Park and not next to or near to caravans.
- 3. Once pitched, caravans and motorhomes are not to be moved without the express permission of the Director of Essential Services.
- 5. The use of electricity in caravans, motorhomes and tents is subject to the conditions set out in the Campsite Electricity Policy.
- 6. The Jamboree will not be held responsible for damage to your property by fire or theft, or injury to persons on-site.
- 7. Audio and / or visual equipment should be played at a respectable volume that does not disturb others.
- 8. Caravans and motorhomes must not be washed on-site.
- 9. All insurance cover is the responsibility of the caravan or motorhome owner, Norjam does not accept any liability.

To prevent issues arising and help resolve them where they do, it is expected that everyone will adopt an open, honest, and positive attitude to fellow campers and the Jamboree Team.
