## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Jamboree is almost here and to help you make the final preparations, here is some important guidance. Please also read the [A-Z of Norjam](#).

### ARRIVAL - SATURDAY 9<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST

The gates will open at 8:00 for the arrival of Leaders.

There will be signposts from the main road and staff on hand to direct you. Young people will arrive to a drop-off point which will be signposted from the road, please make sure you have leaders to meet them to walk them onto site, parents do not enter site.

### KIT DROP OFF - FRIDAY EVENING

There is an opportunity for groups to drop kit off on Friday 8 August from 17:00 to 20:00. One mess tent can be erected to store your kit and there is strictly no camping allowed.

### KIT DROP OFF - SATURDAY DAY TIME

Cars that are delivering group kit to camping areas, can drive onto the subcamp areas and must display the Kit Car Pass to be directed to the right area. [Click Here](#) for Kit Car Pass.

### BOOKING IN ON ARRIVAL

One leader (or two for a bigger contingent) will need to book in and collect all the ID bracelets, neckers and other contingent information. Remember to bring all your registration forms to hand in too.

### PARKING DURING THE JAMBOREE

### DEPARTURE - SATURDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST

The gates will open at 8:00 and all campers must leave site by 12:00. "Take only memories and leave only your footprints" as B.P. said.

### MONEY ON SITE

There will be shops and stalls where you can buy drinks, snacks and souvenirs. All purchases can be made in cash or using card payment.

### SHOPPING DELIVERIES

The St. Walstan building is the drop off point for shopping deliveries. You will need to meet the delivery to unload your shopping – remember to bring shopping bags with you.

### DRONES

Please note that personal drones cannot be brought to or operated at Norjam.

### TOILETS AND SHOWERS

Please note that there will be plenty of facilities across the site including accessible (radar key) and gender inclusive facilities.
