



CODE OF CONDUCT

Our Jamboree is a fantastic and unique event. You will be living alongside hundreds of Scouts and Guides from across the United Kingdom and from around the world and these simple rules will help everyone to have the best Jamboree adventure.

Adults and Young People, as Scouts and Guides, have taken a Promise and all must agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct at Norjam 2025.

RESPECT

We are together as Scout and Guides sharing a Jamboree event. Be understanding of others and respect different cultural attitudes towards personal conduct. Public displays of intimacy are discouraged. Please respect others.

BE SAFE

Make sure you follow our safety guidelines for camping and on all the activities. Our Safety Team are here to help everyone enjoy a safe Jamboree.

JAMBOREE ID

Wear your Jamboree Necker and ID Bracelet at all times unless you are asked to remove it for safety reasons. You will not be able to enter certain areas or take part in activities without it.

CLOTHING

Wear clothing that is suitable for the weather and the activities that you are taking part in. Remember that your dress should be modest, appropriate and non-offensive.

CARE FOR OUR ENVIRONMENT

Please use the bins provided to help keep our Jamboree village clean and tidy.

A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP

Quiet in all camping areas is between 23:00 and 06:30. Please respect fellow campers.

CARE FOR YOURSELF

Ensure that you get plenty of sleep, food and drink to make sure that you stay fit and well.

WE ARE HERE TO HELP

We care for your wellbeing too, our Welfare Team is here to help, and you can share any concerns with the Welfare Team, at any time.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND THE LAW

Alcohol may only be consumed by over 18's, at appropriate times and in appropriate places. Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vapes) are only permitted in designated areas and not inside tents.

The possession, personal use or supply of recreational drugs is illegal and as such, a criminal offence and the law applies to the site.

The Jamboree operates a zero-tolerance approach to illegal and inappropriate behaviour. Anyone found to be breaking the law or acting inappropriately will be removed from site at their own expense and the police will be informed as appropriate.
