IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Jamboree is almost here and to help you make the final preparations, here is some important guidance.

ARRIVAL - SATURDAY 9TH AUGUST

The gates will open at 8:00 for the arrival of staff.

There will be signposts from the main road and staff on hand to direct you.

BOOKING IN ON ARRIVAL

All staff will need to book in and collect all their ID bracelets necker and other information.

Remember to bring your registration forms to hand in too.

DAY STAFF

All day staff will receive their ID Packs on their first day of work. Arrival after Saturday will be the main gate and you will be met at 08:30. If any day staff wish to stay to enjoy some of the evening entertainment, you are welcome but must leave site by 22:30 ahead of night-time curfew.

DEPARTURE - SATURDAY 16 AUGUST

The gates will open at 8:00 and all campers must leave site by 12:00 unless helping with the take-down operation of the Jamboree.

MONEY ON SITE

There will be shops and stalls where you can buy drinks, snacks and souvenirs. All purchases can be made in cash or using card payment.

SHOPPING DELIVERIES

The St. Walstan building is the drop off point for shopping deliveries. You will need to meet the delivery to unload your shopping – remember to bring shopping bags with you.

TAKEAWAY FOOD DELIVERIES

If you order takeaway food deliveries, you must meet the driver outside the security gate.

DRONES

Please note that personal drones cannot be brought to or operated at Norjam.

TOILETS AND SHOWERS

Please note that there will be plenty of facilities across the site including accessible (radar key) and gender inclusive facilities.

STAFF CATERING SPECIAL

Please remember that you need to bring your own plate, bowl, cup and eating irons to use. Also bring some tea towels as you will need to wash and dry your own kit after meals.
