



## STAFF CATERING

If you are part of the Norjam Staff Team, you are very welcome to book a place at the table for staff catering, choose to purchase food from the onsite vendors or self-cater.

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**Norjam is exceptionally grateful that staff catering for Norjam 2025 is being undertaken by His Majesty's Royal Air Force based at RAF Marham, supported by the Chelmsford ASU.**

However, we need to be mindful that RAF Marham is an operational base and that operational duties must take priority. **Thus, this facility may be withdrawn at short notice.**

With various menu choices at every meal, there will be something that you will enjoy from the first meal on the evening of Saturday 9 August to the last breakfast on the morning of Saturday 16 August, for a set catering fee of £95.00, payable in addition to the staff camping fee. Those who book the package will be provided with a hot or cold breakfast, packed lunch and a hot or cold evening meal.

Please note that staff catering is only available for full-time staff and unfortunately is not available for day staff, contractors or visitors.

We are aware that you will want to see fresh food and local produce, and so the menu will reflect these healthy and sustainable choices.

If you have special dietary requirements, the RAF Marham Team is used to catering for these needs and information will be collected as part of the second stage of registration.

The staff catering fee payment schedule is:

- £45.00 deposit to be paid on booking along with your staff deposit
- £50.00 balance is due as part of the final fee payment on 31 January 2025

Staff who are bringing dependent children to Norjam, can also reserve catering for them at the following prices:

- Children aged 10 to 17 years of age – £95.00 payable on 31 January 2025
- Children aged 3 to 9 years of age – £47.50 payable on 31 January 2025
- Children 0 to 2 years of age – eat for free

To make the Norjam catering provision the best eatery in Norfolk, we will ask you follow these simple guidelines:

- You will need to bring your own eating kit (plate, bowl, mug and cutlery) and tea towel
- You will need to wash your own eating kit after every meal and take it away with you
- After you have eaten, you will need to tidy your table by removing all rubbish to ensure it is clean and tidy for the next people to use
- You will need to use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit of the eatery

To prevent issues arising and help resolve them where they do, it is expected that everyone will adopt an open, honest, and positive attitude to fellow campers and the Jamboree Team. All directions and decisions made by the Jamboree Directorate are final.
